ESV	And he went up from there against the inhabitants of Debir. Now the name of Debir formerly was Kiriath-sepher.
NIV	From there he marched against the people living in Debir (formerly called Kiriath Sepher).
NLT	From there he went to fight against the people living in the town of Debir (formerly called Kiriath-sepher).
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀνέβη ἐκεῖθεν Χαλεβ ἐπὶ τοὺς greek The definite article κατοικοῦντας Δαβιρ τὸν greek The definite article δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὄνομα Δαβιρ ἦν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τὸν greek The definite article πρότερον Πόλις γραμμάτων
KJV	And he went up thence to the inhabitants of Debir: and the name of Debir before was Kirjathsepher.

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
