ESV	from Ekron to the sea, all that were by the side of Ashdod, with their villages.
NIV	west of Ekron, all that were in the vicinity of Ashdod, together with their villages;
NLT	From Ekron the boundary extended west and included the towns near Ashdod with their surrounding villages.

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πᾶσαι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big πᾶς

	Meaning
	* All * Every * The whole
	Adjective.
	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ὅσαι εἰσὶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἰμί
	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. πλησίον Ασηδωθ καί plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big καί

	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

	The definite article ὧμαι αὐτῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big αὐτός
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
