In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (לָפָאֵת קִדְמָה זֹאת נִחַלְתָּ בְּנִי בְּנֵימֶן לְגִבּוֹלְתֶּיהָ סָבִיב לְמִשְׁפְּחֹתָם
ESV	The Jordan forms its boundary on the eastern side. This is the inheritance of the people of Benjamin, according to their clans, boundary by boundary all around.
NIV	The Jordan formed the boundary on the eastern side. These were the boundaries that marked out the inheritance of the clans of Benjamin on all sides.
NLT	The eastern boundary was the Jordan River. These were the boundaries of the homeland allocated to the clans of the tribe of Benjamin.
