lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word הַּוֹה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. The word אַכץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

When coupled with heavens (שְׁמִים), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 מָתָּחָת
