For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֶא אֱלֹהֵים ( בָּגָבְעַתֹּ פִּינָחֶס בָּנֹוֹ אֱשֵׁר נִתַּן לִוֹ בִּהֶר אֱפְרֵיִם
