Hebrew	hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 חֲטָבֵי עֲצִים וְשָׂאֲבֵי מַיִם לְכָל הָעֵדָה כְּאֲשֶׁר דִּבְּרוּ לָהֶם הַנְּשִׂאִים
ESV	And the leaders said to them, “Let them live.” So they became cutters of wood and drawers of water for all the congregation, just as the leaders had said of them.
NIV	They continued, “Let them live, but let them be woodcutters and water carriers for the entire community.” So the leaders' promise to them was kept.
NLT	Let them live.” So they made them woodcutters and water carriers for the entire community, as the Israelite leaders directed.

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
