Zebulun did not drive out the inhabitants of Kitron, or the inhabitants of Nahalol, so the Canaanites lived **ESV** among them, but became subject to forced labor.

Neither did Zebulun drive out the Canaanites living in Kitron or Nahalol, who remained among them; but they did subject them to forced labor.

The tribe of Zebulun failed to drive out the residents of Kitron and Nahalol, so the Canaanites continued to NLT live among them. But the Canaanites were forced to work as slaves for the people of Zebulun.
