In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.</div><div>Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) <span>ην</span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</div><div>ειμί</div><div>greek</div><div>ειμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (<span>ειναι</span> [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div><div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
