Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) Σαμψων ἑαυτὸς εἶμιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμι greek LXX εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
