<p>Hebrew</p>	<p>יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* Yahweh - God's personal name</p> <p>It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.</p> <p>First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. Exodus 3:14 Deuteronomy 6:4 Psalm 23:1 Romans 10:13 Joel 2:32 Exodus 20:7 Psalm 18:1 Exodus 15:3 Psalm 8:1 Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3 Judges 6:24 Genesis 22:14 Jeremiah 23:6 לְיְהוָה לְיְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>The word יהוה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</p> <p>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3 Exodus 3:12 Ruth 1:1 Isaiah 2:2 לְיְהוָה לְיְהוָה לְיְהוָה</p>
<p>ESV</p>	<p>Then Micah said, “Now I know that the LORD will prosper me, because I have a Levite as priest.”</p>
<p>NIV</p>	<p>And Micah said, “Now I know that the LORD will be good to me, since this Levite has become my priest.”</p>
<p>NLT</p>	<p>“I know the LORD will bless me now,” Micah said, “because I have a Levite serving as my priest.”</p>
