ESV	In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.
NIV	In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as he saw fit.
NLT	In those days Israel had no king; all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes.

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. βασιλεὺς ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigέν greek Preposition meaning “in”.
