Hebrew	אָרֶץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big אָרֶץ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 אַרְבַּעַיִם שָׁנָה וַיָּמָת עֲתַנְיָאֵל בֶּן קִנָּז
ESV	So the land had rest forty years. Then Othniel the son of Kenaz died.
NIV	So the land had peace for forty years, until Othniel son of Kenaz died.
NLT	So there was peace in the land for forty years. Then Othniel son of Kenaz died.
LXX	καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἡσυχασεν ἡ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ greek The definite article ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology".
