ESV	"Then loud beat the horses' hoofs with the galloping, galloping of his steeds.
NIV	Then thundered the horses' hoofs- galloping, galloping go his mighty steeds.
NLT	Then the horses' hooves hammered the ground, the galloping, galloping of Sisera's mighty steeds.
LXX	τότε ἀπεκόπησαν πτέρναι ἵππου αμαδαρωθ δυνατῶν αὐτοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
