ESV	Between her feet he sank, he fell, he lay still; between her feet he sank, he fell; where he sank, there he fell- dead.
NIV	At her feet he sank, he fell; there he lay. At her feet he sank, he fell; where he sank, there he fell-dead.
NLT	He sank, he fell, he lay still at her feet. And where he sank, there he died.

LXX	ἀνὰ μέσον τῶν greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ὧς greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἔκαμψεν ἐκεῖ ἔπεσεν ταλαίπωρος
KJV	At her feet he bowed, he fell, he lay down: at her feet he bowed, he fell: where he bowed, there he fell down dead.

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
