Hebrew	הִבִּיֵּא בְּכִלְיוֹתַי בְּנֵי אֶשְׁפָּתַי
ESV	He drove into my kidneys the arrows of his quiver;
NIV	He pierced my heart with arrows from his quiver.
NLT	He shot his arrows deep into my heart.
LXX	εἰσήγαγεν τοῖς greek The definite article νεφροῖς μου ἰοὺς φαρέτρας αὐτοῦ αὐτότος greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
KJV	He hath caused the arrows of his quiver to enter into my reins.

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
