ESV	my soul is bereft of peace; I have forgotten what happiness is;
NIV	I have been deprived of peace; I have forgotten what prosperity is.
NLT	Peace has been stripped away, and I have forgotten what prosperity is.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀπώσατο ἐξ εἰρήνης ψυχὴν μου ἐπελαθόμην ἀγαθὰ
KJV	And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgot prosperity.

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
