Hebrew	טוֹב לַעֲבֹר כִּי יִשָּׂא עַל בְּנֵעוּרָיו
ESV	It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.
NIV	It is good for a man to bear the yoke while he is young.
NLT	And it is good for people to submit at an early age to the yoke of his discipline:
LXX	ἀγαθὸν ἀνδρὶ ὅταν ἄρῃ ζυγὸν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. νεότητι αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
