	Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קָרַב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 הָעֵמִים

NIV	You have made us scum and refuse among the nations.
NLT	You have discarded us as refuse and garbage among the nations.
