Hebrew	פָּנִים עוֹרֵנוּ כְּתִנּוֹר נִכְמָרוּ מִפָּנִי hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. זְלַעְפוֹת רָעָב
	ESV Our skin is hot as an oven with the burning heat of famine.
	NIV Our skin is hot as an oven, feverish from hunger.
	NLT The famine has blackened our skin as though baked in an oven.
