Hebrew	בְּחִירִים וְיָהָדוּ וְגַם צְעָרִים יִשְׁחָלוּ
ESV	Young men are compelled to grind at the mill, and boys stagger under loads of wood.
NIV	Young men toil at the millstones; boys stagger under loads of wood.
NLT	Young men are led away to work at millstones, and boys stagger under heavy loads of wood.
LXX	ἐκλεκτοὶ κλαυθμὸν ἀνέλαβον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” greek Preposition meaning “in”. ξύλῳ ἠσθένησαν
KJV	They took the young men to grind, and the children fell under the wood.

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
