	הָיָה תִּזְמוּנִים הָיָה hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 אֵין וְאֵין אֵב אֶמְתִּינוּ כְּאֶלְמָנוֹת
ESV	We have become orphans, fatherless; our mothers are like widows.
NIV	We have become orphans and fatherless, our mothers like widows.
NLT	We are orphaned and fatherless. Our mothers are widowed.
