Hebrew	מִמֵּינִי בְכֶסֶף שְׁתִּינִי עֲצִינִי בְמַחֲרִיר בָּאוּ
ESV	We must pay for the water we drink; the wood we get must be bought.
NIV	We must buy the water we drink; our wood can be had only at a price.
NLT	We have to pay for water to drink, and even firewood is expensive.
LXX	ἐξ ἡμερῶν ἡμῶν ξύλα ἡμῶν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀλλάγματι ἦλθεν
KJV	We have drunken our water for money; our wood is sold unto us.

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
