| ESV    | He shall lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.           |
| NIV    | He is to lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him.      |
| NLT    | Lay your hand on the animal's head, and the LORD will accept its death in your place to purify you, making you right with him. |
