Hebrew	* Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniuquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	And do not go outside the entrance of the tent of meeting, lest you die, for the anointing oil of the LORD is upon you.” And they did according to the word of Moses.

NLT	But you must not leave the entrance of the Tabernacle or you will die, for you have been anointed with the LORD's anointing oil.” So they did as Moses commanded.
