Hebrew	מִבְשָׂרָם לֹא תֹאכְלוּ וּבְנִבְלָתָם לֹא תִגְעוּ טְמֵאִים הֵם לָכֵן
ESV	You shall not eat any of their flesh, and you shall not touch their carcasses; they are unclean to you.
NIV	You must not eat their meat or touch their carcasses; they are unclean for you.
NLT	You may not eat the meat of these animals or even touch their carcasses. They are ceremonially unclean for you.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ὑμῖν			
KJV	Of their flesh shall ye not eat, and their carcase shall ye not touch; they are unclean to you.
