Hebrew	The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by הָאֱלֹהִים (הָאֶחָד מִן הַתַּיִם אֲזַ מִן בְּנֵי הַיּוֹנָה מֵאֲשֶׁר תִּשָּׂיג יָדוֹ
ESV	And he shall offer, of the turtledoves or pigeons, whichever he can afford,
NIV	Then he shall sacrifice the doves or the young pigeons, which the person can afford,
NLT	“Then the priest will offer the two turtledoves or the two young pigeons, whichever the person can afford.
