ESV	And whoever touches her bed shall wash his clothes and bathe himself in water and be unclean until the evening.
NIV	Whoever touches her bed must wash his clothes and bathe with water, and he will be unclean till evening.
NLT	If any of you touch her bed, you must wash your clothes and bathe yourself in water, and you will remain unclean until evening.

	Adjective.
	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → “every” John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ὅς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὅς, ἥ, ὅ

	Meaning:
	* Who * Which * What
	The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).
	It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning <i>ἐάν ᾄσῃται τῆς</i>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὅ, ἥ, τό

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀκάθαρτος ἔσται plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί
	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἔως ἑσπέρας
