

Leviticus 2:4

Hebrew	וְכִי תִקְרַב קָרְבָּן מִנְחָה מֵאֲפֶה תֵנִיךְ סֶלֶת חֲלֹת מִצַּת בְּשֶׁמֶן וּרְקִיקֵי מִצּוֹת מִשְׁחִים בְּשֶׁמֶן
ESV	“When you bring a grain offering baked in the oven as an offering, it shall be unleavened loaves of fine flour mixed with oil or unleavened wafers smeared with oil.
NIV	“If you bring a grain offering baked in an oven, it is to consist of fine flour: cakes made without yeast and mixed with oil, or wafers made without yeast and spread with oil.
NLT	“If your offering is a grain offering baked in an oven, it must be made of choice flour, but without any yeast. It may be presented in the form of thin cakes mixed with olive oil or wafers spread with olive oil.
LXX	ἐὰν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. προσφέρῃ δῶρον θυσίαν πεπεμμένην ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. κλιβάνῳ δῶρον κυρίῳ ἐκ σεμιδάλεως ἄρτους ἄζυμους πεφυραμένους ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἐλαίῳ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” λάγανα ἄζυμα διακεχρισμένα ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἐλαίῳ
KJV	And if thou bring an oblation of a meat offering baked in the oven, it shall be unleavened cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, or unleavened wafers anointed with oil.
