<p>Hebrew</p>	<p>יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>The word יהוה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</p> <p>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* Yahweh - God's personal name</p> <p>It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.</p> <p>First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 אלהים plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big אלהים</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meanings:</p> <p>* God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels</p> <p>Noun, masculine</p>
ESV	Consecrate yourselves, therefore, and be holy, for I am the LORD your God.
NIV	“Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the LORD your God.
NLT	So set yourselves apart to be holy, for I am the LORD your God.

LXX	<p>καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</p> <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἔσθε plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
