ESV	They shall not marry a prostitute or a woman who has been defiled, neither shall they marry a woman divorced from her husband, for the priest is holy to his God.
NIV	"They must not marry women defiled by prostitution or divorced from their husbands, because priests are holy to their God.
NLT	"Priests may not marry a woman defiled by prostitution, and they may not marry a woman who is divorced from her husband, for the priests are set apart as holy to their God.

Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἅγιός ἐστίν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τῷ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
