	יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה? hebrew Meaning Hebrew * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6
ESV	It shall be eaten on the same day; you shall leave none of it until morning: I am the LORD.
NIV	It must be eaten that same day; leave none of it till morning. I am the LORD.
NLT	Eat the entire sacrificial animal on the day it is presented. Do not leave any of it until the next morning. I am the LORD.
LXX	αὐτοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) τοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἡμέρᾱ ἐκείνῃ βρωθήσεται οὐκ ἀπολείψετε ἀπὸ τῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article κρεῶν εἰς τὸ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article πρῶτῃ ἐγὼ εἰμι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. κύριος
