Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἰςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. εἰς κενὸν ἦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

Meaning:

* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ὑμῶν τὸνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
