In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by ארץ (אֶרֶץ) plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
Hebrew	hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word ארץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 אֵינֶיכֶם

NIV	You will perish among the nations; the land of your enemies will devour you.
NLT	You will die among the foreign nations and be devoured in the land of your enemies.

Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.
