Hebrew	וְכָל חֹטֶאת אֲשֶׁר יִזְבֹּחַ מִדָּמָה אֶל אֹהֶל מוֹעֵד לְכַפֵּר בְּקֹדֶשׁ לֹא תֹאכְל בָּאֵשׁ תִּשְׂרֹף
ESV	Every grain offering of a priest shall be wholly burned. It shall not be eaten."
NIV	Every grain offering of a priest shall be burned completely; it must not be eaten."
NLT	All such grain offerings of a priest must be burned up entirely. None of it may be eaten."
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" πᾶσα greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 θυσία ἱερῆως ὁλόκαυτος ἔσται greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be"). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" οὐ βρωθήσεται
KJV	For every meat offering for the priest shall be wholly burnt: it shall not be eaten.
