Hebrew	
ESV	But no sin offering shall be eaten from which any blood is brought into the tent of meeting to make atonement in the Holy Place; it shall be burned up with fire.
NIV	But any sin offering whose blood is brought into the Tent of Meeting to make atonement in the Holy Place must not be eaten; it must be burned.
NLT	But the offering for sin may not be eaten if its blood was brought into the Tabernacle as an offering for purification in the Holy Place. It must be completely burned with fire.

	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
