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Meaning	
	* Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial
	Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.
	From the root נָסַח, meaning "to come near, approach." So נֶמֶס is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7/Psalm 103:1
ESV	And all its fat shall be offered, the fat tail, the fat that covers the entrails,
NIV	All its fat shall be offered: the fat tail and the fat that covers the inner parts.
NLT	The priest will then offer all its fat on the altar, including the fat of the broad tail, the fat around the internal organs.

KJV And he shall offer of it all the fat thereof; the rump, and the fat that covereth the inwards.

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
