	The Hebrew אַת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article מַאָּת בְּנֵי יִשְּׂרָאֵל חָפַּת עוֹלֶם לְדרֹתֶם Genesis 1:1 מֵאָת בְּנֵי יִשְּׂרָאֵל חָפַּת עוֹלֶם לְדרֹתֶם
ESV	The LORD commanded this to be given them by the people of Israel, from the day that he anointed them. It is a perpetual due throughout their generations."
