Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את־ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהִים (לִקְדָּשׁוֹ

NIV	He poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head and anointed him to consecrate him.
NLT	Then he poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head, anointing him and making him holy for his work.
