Hebrew	יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	As has been done today, the LORD has commanded to be done to make atonement for you.
NIV	What has been done today was commanded by the LORD to make atonement for you.
