Hebrew	The Hebrew וְ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by וְהָאֲדָמָה וְהָאֲרֶזֶת וְהַיָּבֵשֶׁת וְהַיָּם
ESV	But the fat pieces of the ox and of the ram, the fat tail and that which covers the entrails and the kidneys and the long lobe of the liver.
NIV	But the fat portions of the ox and the ram—the fat tail, the layer of fat, the kidneys and the covering of the liver.
NLT	Then he took the fat of the bull and the ram—the fat of the broad tail and from around the internal organs—along with the kidneys and the long lobes of the livers.
