IT is most frequently translated as “and” <span>ἔσταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</span></div><div>greek</div><div>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div><div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
