	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” σύ, Καφαρναούμ, μὴ ἕως οὐρανοῦ
Greek	αὐτοῦ οὐρανός Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 ὕψωθήσῃ; ἕως ᾧδου καταβιβασθήσῃ.
ESV	And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You shall be brought down to Hades.
NIV	And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted up to the skies? No, you will go down to the depths.
NLT	And you people of Capernaum, will you be honored in heaven? No, you will go down to the place of the dead. “
KJV	And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.

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
