εἷς is the cardinal number ("one"). Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun ("someone" or "a certain one"). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐστινρlugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example $\epsilon l \mu l$ is the word for am and $\tilde{l} \nu$ is the word for was, e.g. $\chi \rho \epsilon l \alpha \cdot M \alpha \rho l \alpha \gamma \alpha \rho \tau \dot{\eta} \nu \rho l u ginautotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigò, <math>\dot{\eta}$, $\tau \dot{\rho}$
