Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 δώσει πνεῦμα ἅγιον τοῖς

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
