Greek	<p>greek</p> <p>The definite article προφητῶν τὸ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article ἐκχυννόμενον ἀπὸ καταβολῆς κόσμου ἀπὸ τῆς</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article γενεᾶς ταύτης, οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it</p> <p>Demonstrative pronoun.</p> <p>οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19</p>
ESV	<p>so that the blood of all the prophets, shed from the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation,</p>
NIV	<p>Therefore this generation will be held responsible for the blood of all the prophets that has been shed since the beginning of the world,</p>

NLT	“As a result, this generation will be held responsible for the murder of all God's prophets from the creation of the world-
KJV	That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;
