Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" αὐ

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The definite article τῶν

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The definite article κεφαλῆς ὑμῶν πᾶσαι

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Meaning

\* All \* Every \* The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 ἡρίθμηνται. μὴ φοβεῖσθε· πολλῶν στρουθίων διαφέρετε.
