IT is most frequently translated as “and” εὐρῶν ἐπιτίθησιν ἐπὶ τοὺς greek Meaning: * The Greek The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ὧμους αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) χαίρων,
ESV	And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.
NIV	And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders
NLT	And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders.
KJV	And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

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
