	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. αὐτῷ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek
	Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό greek
	Meaning: * The The definite article.
	Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ τῇ προφητῶν οὐκ ἀκούουσιν, οὐδέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὐδέ greek
	Meaning * Not * Nor * Neither * Not even
	A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses. It often functions like English Matthew 6:20John 7:5Romans 3:10 ἐάν τις ἐκ νεκρῶν ἀναστῇ πεισθήσονται.
ESV	He said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the Prophets, neither will they be convinced if someone should rise from the dead.'

NIV	"He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'"
NLT	"But Abraham said, 'If they won't listen to Moses and the prophets, they won't listen even if someone rises from the dead.'"
KJV	And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

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
