	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἰπὼν ταῦτα οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐπορεύετο ἔμπροσθεν ἀναβαίνων, εἰς Ἱεροσόλυμα.
ESV	And when he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.
NIV	After Jesus had said this, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.
NLT	After telling this story, Jesus went on toward Jerusalem, walking ahead of his disciples.
KJV	And when he had thus spoken, he went before, ascending up to Jerusalem.

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
