Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

## Greek greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example  $\epsilon l\mu l$  is the word for am and l l is the word for was, e.g.  $\pi \alpha \nu \tau l$  pluginautotooltip default pluginautotooltip big $\pi \alpha c$

\* All \* Every \* The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of  $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta$  depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
